4:00-4:30 judging, pictures and clean up

First, Second and Third Place for each age group.









Rules:

Space is limited and will be awarded on a first come basis. Registration sheets will be available the day of the competition. Participants will forfeit their space, if not on site by five minutes after the hour when the competition begins for their age category.

Participants must stop working on their project at the ending time set for their age group.

Entries may be an individual or a pair.

There is only one entry per person or pair.

Please note that while all participants will receive a certificate, individuals and pairs will compete for a single prize.

Pair Projects will be placed in the category of the oldest participant.

Projects may not be over 3 feet in height.

Entries must be your creation, not a Lego designed kit, project found online, in a magazine, book, etc.

Participants must use the building materials provided on site. You may not bring building blocks from home.

Although participants may come and go during the competition, projects will be judged on what is completed at the end of the designated time.
